



RoHS LETTER of GUARANTEE

BJK Flexible Packaging certifies that each shipment or other delivery of polyethylene film and bags produced by BJK shall comply with the requirements of the toxics in packaging law, specifically:

- The regulated metals – Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, and Hexavalent Chromium – were not intentionally added to any packaging component during the manufacturing process and their content in any package or package component is below 100 ppm by weight.
- Materials comply with the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetics Act and are not manufactured with any of the Primary Allergens (milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, fish, shellfish, soy or wheat). Our products are also free of latex or PVC.
- Polyethylene film and bags produced by BJK were not manufactured with:
 - Bisphenol-A (BPA) or BPA derived plastics
 - Melamine
 - Pthalate Plasticizers
 - Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA)
 - Chlorofluorocarbons (CFC's)
- The manufacturing processes employed by BJK Flexible Packaging do not employ raw materials (resins, additives and processing aids) known to contain fungicides, synthetic pesticides, herbicides or fumigants. It is BJK's opinion that our packaging materials comply with the requirements of the National Organic Program, 7 CFR 205.272 for packaging of organic food.
- BJK products are not manufactured with Halogenated Organic Flame Retardants, Carcinogens or Reproductive Toxicants (below Prop 65 Safe Harbor Levels), Postconsumer Recycled Content, and are Classified as Non-Hazardous Waste.
